# THE NATURAL PROCESS

Aquamation is a more natural and environmentally friendly alternative to cremations and burials.

It uses water instead of fire to return the body to nature.

Aquamation is the same process that occurs in nature-alkaline hydrolysis.

This is the natural way in which a body returns to nature if placed in a flowing stream of water or directly in the topsoil. Pacemakers do not need to be removed prior to the process, and items such as titanium hip implants can be reused as they remain intact and sterile.


Also items of jewellery, gold teeth and other implants are all recovered at the end of the process.

#### WHAT ACTUALLY HAPPENS?



The body is gently placed in a clean, stainless steel vessel. A combination of water flow, temperature and alkalinity are used to accelerate the natural process. At the end of the process, the body has been returned to its natural form. Remember – our bodies are 70% water to begin with! The only solid remains are the bones.
